Valle Central, Chile 3.25 4.25 5.75 14.95
Lively citrus, lush herbaceous notes and juicy, tropical flavours.
2. Blue Ridge Chardonnay,
Bulgaria 3.25 4.25 5.75 14.95
Fresh, light, medium-bodied, lemon and white peach fruit, subtle creamy notes.
3. Papatruda Pinot Grigio,
Viile Timisului, Romania 3.50 4.50 5.95 15.95
Light-bodied, crisp and intense, lively flavours of pear, apple and blossom.
4. La Petite Vigne Viognier,
IGP d'Oc, France 16.95
Crisp and sleek, classic perfumed notes of peach and apricot, dry zesty citrus finish.
5. Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine des Lauriers,
Coteaux du Languedoc, France 17.95
Dry and steely, expressive floral highlights, generous stone fruits, racy and lip-smacking.
6. Waverider Sauvignon Blanc,
Marlborough, New Zealand 18.95
Lively and refreshing, full of classic juicy lime fruit and fresh, aromatic green herbs.
7. Mâcon-Vergisson 'Les Rochers'
Domaine Guerrin & Fils, France 23.95
Very fine and dry, rather Chablis-like with lovely minerality and delicate baked bread aromas.
8. Pouilly-Fumé, Domaine & Fils des Fines
Caillottes, Jean Pabiot, France 29.95
A modern, highly characterful Old World Sauvignon, complex tropical fruit, lovely mineral notes.
9. Saint-Aubin 1er cru Remilly,
Henri Prudhon, France 37.50
Meursault style and class on a budget, wonderful mineral expression, pretty white flowers and orchard fruit flavours, fine smoky oak and nervy citrus-like acidity.

Valle Central, Chile 3.25 4.25 5.75 14.95
Medium-bodied, soft and round, violet-tinged dark fruits, a little wood spice and toast.
11. Papatruda Pinot Noir,
Viile Timisului, Romania 3.50 4.50 5.95 15.95
Light-bodied, juicy and generous, exotic spices, crunchy black fruit, pretty strawberry notes.
12. Freedom Cross Pinotage,
Western Cape, South Africa 16.95
Medium-bodied, broad and youthful, full of berry fruits, mocha and smoky earth.
13. Montepulciano d'Abbruzzo DOC,
Volupta, Italy 17.95
Sourced from select vineyards in Pescara and Chieti, well rounded with rich, spicy cherry and damson fruit.
14. Arjona,
Rioja, Spain 3.95 4.95 6.50 18.95
Rich and smooth, sweet berry fruit flavours, creamy vanilla and toasted oak. A youthful, unoaked Rioja with some oak-aged (crianza) wine blended in.
15. Cucao CS Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon,
Colchagua Valley, Chile 19.95
Fresh and refined, classic notes of leafy blackcurrant, a touch of camphor, ink and spicy berry fruits - thanks to a drop of Syrah in the blend.
16. Don Cristóbal 1492 Malbec,
Mendoza, Argentina 20.95
Perfumed dark and red fruit, notes of violet and subtle spice from French oak barrels. Elegant and modern with velvety tannins and a satisfyingly crisp and savoury long finish.
17. Château Argadens, Bordeaux Supérieur,
France 22.50
Owned by Sichel, this property is situated in the Entre-deux-Mers and produces robust and softly-fruited claret. Offering a little maturity, very supple tannins and perfect balance.
18. Nebbiolo Langhe DOC, Roccabella,
Eugenio Bocchino, Italy 37.50
A baby Barolo from an excellent organic/biodynamic producer, this is full-bodied, succulent and incredibly pretty, with notes of cherry, lavender, liquorice and fine oak.
